AIRCRAFT EMERGENCY LANDING NEAR SEDENAK, JOHOR

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia confirms that a light aircraft type Beechcraft Model 35 Bonanza has made an emergency landing on PLUS highway near Sedenak, Johor on Sunday morning, 22 November 2020. CAAM Johor's Air Traffic Control Tower received a call at 10.40am from the aircraft pilot requesting for a return landing at Senai International Airport, Johor Bahru due to technical problems. The private aircraft, operated by Premier Air Singapore was enroute from Seletar Airport, Singapore to Melaka.

The two Singaporean pilots on board are reportedly in stable condition and the aircraft has been moved to a position that does not obstruct traffic on the highway. Search and rescue teams have completed all required tasks. The investigation will be conducted by the Air Accident Investigation Bureau under the Ministry of Transport Malaysia.
