TRAINING FLIGHT SKIDDED OFF RUNWAY AT LANGKAWI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms an accident involving an aircraft on a night training flight at Langkawi International Airport at 8:04 PM on Wednesday, 30 March 2022. The Diamond DA-40D, 9M-HMW operated by HM Aerospace Sdn. Bhd. (HMA) had landed and veered off the runway upon touchdown.

The pilot in command is currently receiving medical assistance and is in stable condition. The aircraft sustained structural damage and was removed at 10:25 PM to ensure safe operations of the runway. The runway was re-opened for scheduled commercial flights at 10:29 PM. The safety investigation will be conducted by the Air Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) under the Ministry of Transport Malaysia in accordance with Part XXVI Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.
