TREATMENT / HOSPITALIZATION MEDICAL REPORT

1. Pertaining to Regulation 155 (2), Civil Aviation Regulations 2016, a person who holds an Air Traffic Controller Licence who suffers any injury / illness / pregnancy / treatment / hospitalization requires treatment involving incapacity to undertake the function to which the licence relates, until the licence holder being medically examined under arrangement made by the Authority and pronounced fit to resume his functions under the licence.
