TRAINING FLIGHT FORCED LANDED NEAR JASIN, MELAKA

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms an aircraft on a training flight had made a forced landing in Jasin, Melaka due to a mechanical malfunction, as reported by the pilot. The Piper PA-28-181, 9MSKJ operated by Malaysian Flying Academy (MFA) requested the air traffic control tower for a priority landing at Malacca International Airport. However, it made a forced landing near Xinyi Energy Smart Factory, Jasin, Melaka at 11:05am on Tuesday, 14 February 2023.

An instructor and a student were on board and no casualties were reported. The safety investigation will be conducted by the Air Accident Investigation Bureau under the Ministry of Transport Malaysia in accordance with Part XXVI Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.
