ADJUSTMENT ON ECLIPSE FULL IMPLEMENTATION

1 Introduction

- 1.1 On 3 January 2023, the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) launched the Electronic Personnel Licensing (EPL) system known as electronic CAAM Licensing Professional Services (eCLIPSE).
- 1.2 The main goal of EPL is to enhance the safety, security, and efficiency of the Personnel Licensing system for CAAM licence holders that includes pilots, engineers, and air traffic controllers. The implementation of EPL is a complex task as the security and accuracy of information must be guaranteed to protect the privacy of the licence holder.
- 1.3 This Advisory Information (AI) is issued to notify CAAM licence holders and related aviation stakeholders on the adjustment to the timeline for the full implementation of eCLIPSE as addressed in AI 29/2022.

2 Implementation

- 2.1 In our commitment to ensure a seamless and successful implementation of eCLIPSE, upon careful assessment, CAAM has extended the timeline for the full implementation of eCLIPSE.
- 2.2 The decision was made to ensure a smooth transition and optimal performance to the system, taking into consideration compliance and adherence to the latest amendment of ICAO Standard and Recommended Practice on Annex 1 and Doc 9379 that laid out technical requirements for robustness, sustainability, and interoperability of EPL to the extent required to support the surveillance activities of other States' Aviation Authority.

- 2.3 CAAM is actively addressing any potential challenges, working diligently to make necessary refinements to certain aspects of eCLIPSE and optimising the overall implementation plan. This adjustment will ultimately result in a more robust and effective implementation of eCLIPSE.
- 2.4 The revised date for the full implementation of eCLIPSE will be communicated in due course. During this period, all licensing applications will continue to be processed and issued without disruption. The use of both the current hard copy licence and EPL will be accepted by CAAM.
- 2.5 CAAM is committed to remain focused on delivering a reliable and efficient online system that meets the evolving needs of CAAM licence holders and aviation stakeholders. CAAM will continue to keep the industry informed about any further developments or updates regarding the changes to the system.
