AIRCRAFT NOSEWHEEL COLLAPSED ON RUNWAY AT MELAKA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms an incident involving an aircraft on a training flight at Melaka International Airport at 12:16 p.m. on Friday, 18 August 2023. The Piper PA-28-181, 9M-ITQ operated by International Aero Training Academy (IATAC), nosewheel collapsed upon landing on runway.

There was one pilot on board and no casualties were reported. The aircraft has been removed to ensure safe operations of the airport. The safety investigation will be conducted by the Air Accident Investigation Bureau under the Ministry of Transport Malaysia in accordance with Part XXVI of the Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.
