LIGHT AIRCRAFT EMERGENCY LANDING AT SULTAN ABDUL AZIZ SHAH AIRPORT, SUBANG, SELANGOR

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms a Diamond DA-42 light aircraft with registration number N566CB, operated by Techstrait Ltd., made an emergency landing at Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport, Subang, Selangor, on April 26, 2024.

The aircraft departed at 8:26 a.m. from Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport and the Subang Air Traffic Control Tower received an emergency call shortly after takeoff. The aircraft made an emergency landing at 8:28 a.m. Two pilots onboard are reported safe.

The runway is temporarily closed for aviation operations until the aircraft is removed from the runway.

Further investigation will be conducted by the Air Accident Investigation Bureau under the Ministry of Transport, in accordance with Part XXVI of the Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.
