LIGHT AIRCRAFT EMERGENCY LANDING NEAR PORT KLANG, SELANGOR

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms a light aircraft Piper PA-28-161 with registration 9M-ANA, operated by Subang Flying Club, made an emergency landing in open space near Port Klang, Selangor, on 27 June 2024. The aircraft departed from Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport, Subang at 2:50 p.m. carrying two passengers and a Mayday call was received by the Subang Control Tower at 2:58 p.m.

The Kuala Lumpur Aeronautical Rescue Coordination Center (KLARCC) of the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) at the Kuala Lumpur Air Traffic Control Center (KLATCC) was activated at 3:10 p.m. for the coordination of rescue operations.

The investigation will be conducted in accordance with Part XXIII of the Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.
