TEMPORARY AIRSPACE CLOSURE & PROHIBITION OF DRONE ACTIVITIES IN CONJUNCTION WITH NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATION 2025

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) wishes to inform on the closure of airspace within the Kuala Lumpur Terminal Control Area from 26 to 29 August and 31 August 2025 to facilitate rehearsals and the National Day flypast in Putrajaya. The flypast will feature 33 aircraft from Malaysian enforcement agencies including helicopters and fixed-wings aircraft.

These closures are essential to ensure the safety of the public and aircraft participating in the flypast. During this period, members of the public may notice increased aircraft activity and some adjustments to commercial flight operations.

CAAM would like to remind the public that all drone or Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) activities are strictly prohibited within the affected areas throughout the rehearsals and National Day celebration. Unauthorized drone operations pose serious safety risks and offenders may face enforcement action under the Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.

CAAM seeks the cooperation of all stakeholders and the public to ensure the smooth and safe execution of the National Day celebrations.

PENUTUPAN SEMENTARA RUANG UDARA & LARANGAN AKTIVITI DRON SEMPENA SAMBUTAN HARI KEBANGSAAN 2025

PUTRAJAYA – Pihak Berkuasa Penerbangan Awam Malaysia (CAAM) akan melaksanakan penutupan ruang udara di Kawasan Kawalan Terminal Kuala Lumpur bermula 26 hingga 29 Ogos serta 31 Ogos 2025 sebagai persediaan raptai dan pelaksanaan lintas hormat sempena sambutan Hari Kebangsaan 2025 di Putrajaya. Lintas hormat ini akan melibatkan sebanyak 33 pesawat daripada agensi penguatkuasaan Malaysia termasuk helikopter dan pesawat fixed-wing.

Penutupan ini adalah penting bagi memastikan keselamatan orang awam serta pesawat yang mengambil bahagian dalam lintas hormat tersebut. Sepanjang tempoh ini, akan berlaku peningkatan aktiviti penerbangan serta pelarasan terhadap operasi penerbangan komersial.

CAAM ingin mengingatkan orang ramai bahawa semua pengendalian aktiviti dron dan sistem pesawat tanpa pemandu (UAS) di kawasan yang terlibat sepanjang raptai dan sambutan Hari Kebangsaan adalah dilarang sama sekali. Pengendalian dron tanpa kelulusan boleh mendatangkan risiko keselamatan kepada operasi pesawat terbang rendah dan pelanggaran terhadap larangan ini boleh dikenakan tindakan penguatkuasaan di bawah Peraturan-Peraturan Penerbangan Awam 2016.

CAAM menyeru kerjasama semua pihak berkepentingan serta orang ramai untuk mematuhi larangan ini bagi memastikan kelancaran dan keselamatan penganjuran sambutan Hari Kebangsaan 2025.
