## AIRCRAFT INCIDENT AT SULTAN ABDUL HALIM AIRPORT, ALOR SETAR, KEDAH

**ALOR SETAR, KEDAH** - The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms an incident involving Malaysia Airlines Berhad's Boeing 737 aircraft, registration number 9M-MXH at Sultan Abdul Halim Airport, Alor Setar, Kedah, on Tuesday, 30 December 2025, at 3.41 p.m.

The aircraft, which was scheduled to depart from Sultan Abdul Halim Airport to Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), aborted its take-off after experiencing a tyre burst.

All passengers and crew are reported safe and have disembarked the aircraft. The runway is temporarily closed until further advice. Passengers travelling through Sultan Abdul Halim Airport are advised to contact their respective airlines for further information.
