Responsible for the economic regulation and oversight of airport development in Malaysia, including the formulation and implementation of regulatory frameworks governing aviation services charges and aerodrome operations. The unit evaluates airport-related proposals, regulatory submissions, and industry performance to ensure airport operations are financially sustainable and economically efficient. This includes the implementation of key regulations such as the Aviation Services Charges (ASC) Regulations, oversight of ground handling policy and licensing reforms, and monitoring of aerodrome operators' operational and financial performance through structured reporting. The unit also supports regulatory decision-making through industry research, stakeholder engagement with relevant ministries and agencies, and the preparation of board and committee submissions, contributing to the long-term resilience and competitiveness of the industry.
