The role ensures compliance with the Air Traffic Management Security Policy (ANSP) 8, International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Annex 17, the Office of the Chief Government Security Officer (CGSO) *Arahan Keselamatan*, the National Cyber Security Agency (NACSA) Cyber Security Baseline, and other applicable regulatory requirements. The incumbent develops and implements security policies, conducts inspections and audits, manages security risks and incidents, collaborates with relevant stakeholders, and drives continuous improvements to ensure the security, resilience, and continuity of Malaysia's air navigation services.
