Qualifications for Appointment

Candidates must possess the following criteria:

a) Citizenship

- Holds, or has previously held an Air Traffic Control (ATC) licence with the relevant rating(s), supported by a minimum of three (3) years of operational experience for each rating.
- Preference will be given to candidates who have completed any of the following courses or qualifications:

 - On-the-Job Training Instructor (OJTI);
 - ICAO Training Instructors Course (TIC);
 - Train-the-Trainer (INTAN); or
 - Other equivalent instructor qualifications.
- Has achieved a minimum English Language Proficiency (ELP) Level 4. Candidates with ELP Level 5 or above will have an added advantage.
- Minimum of five (5) years of experience in ATC service operations.
