Job Description

To support the Assistant Manager in overseeing Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) Pre-Defined Risk Assessments (PDRA), including evaluating applications for UAS operations under predefined risk assessment frameworks through the pre-application, formal application, document review, audit, demonstration, and certification stages. The Executive – PDRA is responsible for reviewing applications against PDRA requirements, including UAS platform suitability, operational limitations, and predefined risk mitigation measures, conducting detailed document reviews and technical, operational, and safety assessments, providing recommendations for regulatory decisions and continued oversight, and supporting the improvement of PDRA policies, procedures, and implementation frameworks to ensure safe, consistent, and standardised UAS operations within CAAM.

Qualifications for Appointment

Candidates must possess the following criteria:

a) Citizenship

- Malaysian citizen.

b) Academic and Professional Qualifications

- Minimum Bachelor's Degree in a related field from a higher education institution recognized by the Government.
- Bachelor's Degree in Aviation Management, Aviation Safety, Aerospace Engineering, Aeronautical Engineering, Air Transport Management, or other aviation-related disciplines would be an advantage.
- Minimum 3 years of aviation-related experience involving one or more of the following:
 - i. Aviation operational oversight or safety management.
 - ii. UAS, RPAS, or aviation operational activities.

- iii. Compliance monitoring, operational assessment, or regulatory activities.
- iv. Audit, inspection, or quality assurance activities.
- v. Stakeholder engagement and operational coordination.
