To support the Assistant Manager in overseeing Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) Standard Scenarios (STS), including developing and implementing STS frameworks for common UAS operations based on CAAM-approved risk assessments. The Executive – STS is responsible for reviewing and evaluating operator submissions and declarations, assessing technical, operational, and safety aspects, ensuring compliance with STS conditions and risk mitigations, providing technical recommendations, coordinating with internal divisions and external stakeholders, and supporting the improvement of STS policies, procedures, and oversight frameworks to ensure safe, efficient, and standardised UAS operations within CAAM.

Qualifications for Appointment

Candidates must possess the following criteria:

a) Citizenship

- Malaysian citizen.

b) Academic and Professional Qualifications

- Minimum Bachelor's Degree in a related field from a higher education institution recognized by the Government.
- Bachelor's Degree in Aviation Management, Aviation Safety, Aerospace Engineering, Aeronautical Engineering, Air Transport Management, or other aviation-related disciplines would be an advantage.
- Minimum 3 years of aviation-related experience involving one or more of the following:
 - i. Aviation operational oversight or regulatory activities.
 - ii. UAS, RPAS, or aviation operational activities.
 - iii. Compliance monitoring, operational assessment, or declaration-based operations.

- v. Stakeholder engagement and operational coordination.
