Job Description

To support the Assistant Manager in regulating Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) Agricultural Work Certificates (UAWC), particularly for agricultural operations involving pesticides and fertilisers. The Executive – UAWC is responsible for reviewing and assessing applications, evaluating documents, conducting audits and demonstrations, and ensuring compliance with aviation regulations, safety standards, and operational requirements. The role also involves conducting technical, operational, safety, and air risk assessments, providing recommendations for regulatory decisions, and maintaining continued oversight of UAWC holders.

Qualifications for Appointment

Candidates must possess the following criteria:

a) Citizenship

- Malaysian citizen.

b) Academic and Professional Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree in a related field from a higher education institution recognized by the Government.
- Bachelor's Degree in Aviation Management, Aviation Safety, Aerospace Engineering, Aeronautical Engineering, Air Transport Management, or other aviation-related disciplines would be an advantage.
- Minimum 3 years of aviation-related experience involving one or more of the following:
 - i. Aviation operational oversight or safety management.
 - ii. Agricultural aviation or UAS agricultural operations.
 - iii. UAS, RPAS, or aviation operational activities.
 - iv. Audit, inspection, compliance monitoring, or regulatory activities.
 - v. Stakeholder engagement and operational coordination.

- Ability to evaluate agricultural UAS operations, operational procedures, dispensing activities, and safety measures in accordance with approved requirements.
- Ability to interpret and apply aviation regulations, agricultural operational requirements, and safety standards consistently.
