HELICOPTER CRASH NEAR LONG LELLANG STOLPORT, SARAWAK

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms that a BO-105 helicopter, registration number 9M-LLF crashed near the Long Lellang STOLport, Sarawak, today. CAAM received notification of the incident from the Flight Information Service at 3.58 p.m.

The helicopter was operating a Flying Doctor Service flight with five persons on board including the pilot.

The Air Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), under the Ministry of Transport Malaysia, will investigate the incident in accordance with Part XXVI of the Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.
