



**INFORMATION TO AVIATION INDUSTRY ON
THE ISSUANCE OF EXEMPTION NOTICE
NOTICE 6/2020**

PUTRAJAYA – Pursuant to the Movement Control Order (MCO) issued by the Government of Malaysia, the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) will grant an extension until the 30th June 2020 on the validity of certificates, approvals, licenses and permits that are expiring between 18th March 2020 until 31st May 2020.

An Exemption Notice (Civil Aviation Notice 1/2020) has been issued out in regards to this. This exemption is meant to provide relief to affected organizations and individuals, while still maintaining aviation operations activities to an acceptable level of safety.

In reference to Notice 3/2020, One Stop Centre operation will be closed starting from 13th April 2020. Meanwhile, application for Dangerous Goods can be submitted at the designated DROP BOX provided at the Lobby, Podium A, CAAM Putrajaya on Monday to Friday from 9AM to 4PM. Fee payments can be made via Electronic Fund Transfer.

CAAM is closely monitoring the situation regarding COVID-19 and should there be any changes to the current status, CAAM will notify its aviation stakeholders accordingly.
